Several Cuyahoga County district superintendents serve on our Board, helping us maintain a keen awareness of the fiscal realities schools are facing. Our budget is developed with that in mind, and we make it a priority to keep costs at their lowest while providing quality comprehensive services.

In an effort to manage costs we have frozen all staff salaries for three years and kept our costs to districts at the same level for two years. So that staff could realize a small increase, costs for the 2014-2015 school year reflect a 3% increase.

This summer, as always, PEP is operating weekly psychiatric clinics for students receiving psychiatric services at PEP. The service is free of charge to districts. Case managers are on call and will be actively working throughout the summer.

At the request of several districts, PEP is developing additional services for students whose challenging behavior exceeds the level that can be managed in a PEP Day Treatment Center. We expect these services to be ready to launch early in the coming school year and will send detailed information at that time.
