Make-Up fittings will be done by appointment only, please contact the uniform committee below if there is an issue with your scheduled time.

The Band Boosters take great pride in the appearance of the Band Members. Because thousands of dollars have been earned and spent to provide Marching Band, Symphonic Band, Concert Band, and Wind Ensemble uniforms, we expect respect and consideration be given by all our Band Members for all that is provided.

Those parts of the uniform that members must purchase are:

1. Summer Band Shirts (\$12.00 – If you already own, no need to purchase)
2. Summer Band Shorts (\$15.00 – If you already own, no need to purchase)
3. White Gloves (\$3.00 - If you already own, no need to purchase)
4. **White Tennis Shoes** and Socks for Summer Uniform

*Note: Items 1-3 are available for purchase at your uniform fitting day. **HOWEVER, if you have not yet placed your order for a summer uniform, please contact Denise Eder (440-717-1170) as soon as possible. We cannot guarantee having all sizes available at uniform fitting or in time for Cedar Point.**

UNIFORM POLICY

Only a representative from the Uniform Committee is authorized to issue replacement parts for lost items. Occasionally, alterations are necessary; please see a Uniform Committee person if there are any problems or concerns.

Identification numbers are recorded on **ALL** items! Each member is responsible for the uniform parts assigned to them. **Band members will be charged for lost or damaged uniforms.**

Marching Uniforms:

- **Your uniform must be hung properly on a form-fitting hanger in your garment bag when not being worn. Take care of your uniform!!!**
- After each marching event, wash the detachable collar liner, and gloves.
- ALWAYS wear the *band-issued* T-Shirt under your uniform jacket.
- **DO NOT** leave uniform parts in the band room, or give them to Band Directors.
- **NEVER** leave a damp or wet uniform rolled up or in a garment bag, they must air dry at home. When a uniform is completely dry, most mud spatters will brush off. Directors will advise when uniforms are to be taken home.
- Uniforms may be professionally dry cleaned by **Cloak and Hanger ONLY**. Never use coin operated or bulk cleaning. Cloak and Hanger (at the corner of Pleasant Valley and Broadview Heights) has the specific cleaning instructions from the uniform company.
- No pins or decorations may be worn on the uniform.
- Members with **long hair** must put their hair up or a hair-pulling rubber band will be issued prior to marching; it is not to touch the letter "B" on the back of the jacket. Hair cannot just be tucked up in the hat.
- Only stud earrings may be worn with the uniform
- **Raincoats** are issued as needed. Check the pockets before returning the raincoat!

Concert Uniforms:

- This uniform should be neatly kept at home. Keep the uniform hanging at all times.
- White shirts should be washed after each performance.
- Skirts are to be returned with their original skirt hanger.

Again, please arrive at your designated fitting time. Parents, please do a head lice check before the hat fitting. **Please be patient!** We are all volunteers! Fitting students in the appropriate uniform takes time.

If you cannot make your uniform fitting night, need other special arrangements, or have any questions, please contact one of us one week prior to fitting night. Also, we are always looking for extra volunteers. If anyone would like to be on the committee or help with these fitting days, please let us know.
