2020-2021 School Year will Start with Hybrid Learning Model

August 7th, 2020

At a Work Session earlier today, the BBHCSD Board of Education made the decision that all students will return to school for the 2020-2021 School Year following the in-person, hybrid learning model as outlined in the District [Reset and Restart Plan](#), through Thanksgiving Break regardless if the county color designation changes to orange or yellow. This is to provide some consistency for families who are planning for the upcoming start to the school year. Should the county move to purple, we will move to remote learning for all students. The community can watch the discussion that took place at the Work Session by [clicking the nearby link](#).

Under this in-person, hybrid model, students K-12 whose names begin with the letters A-L will attend in-person classes for the ENTIRE SCHOOL DAY on Mondays and Tuesdays. Those students with the last names beginning with the letters M-Z will attend in-person classes for the ENTIRE SCHOOL DAY on Thursdays and Fridays. Wednesdays, *for all students and staff*, will be a remote learning/cleaning day throughout the entire District.

Early next week, the BBHCSD will be releasing to the community its final Online Learning Plan, Remote Learning and Hybrid Learning Plan for the community's review. At that time, you will be asked to participate in a survey declaring your child's intent to participate in online learning for the first semester. Those participating in person, will be asked questions about your intended school transportation use.

Once again, students K-12 in the BBHCSD will begin the 2020-2021 School Year in a Hybrid learning model whereby those with last names beginning with letters A-L will attend in-person classes for the ENTIRE SCHOOL DAY on Mondays and Tuesdays. Those students with the last names beginning with the letters M-Z will attend in-person classes for the ENTIRE SCHOOL DAY on Thursdays and Fridays. Wednesdays, *for all students and staff*, will be a remote learning/cleaning day. This will run through Thanksgiving Break and then switch to the mandatory full remote period between November 30th, 2020 and December 18th, 2020. At this time, we will reevaluate where the county is in this pandemic and make a decision about how we will return on January 4th, 2021.
