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Return to 5-Day In-Person Learning Important Reminders

Students, staff and parents at Brecksville-Broadview Heights *High School* will return to 5-Day, In-Person Learning on Monday, October 26th. Together safely, the District is posting these **Important Reminders** so that everyone in our learning family can be better prepared for this return to learning every day. Please see the information below about critical aspects of daily life in the BBHCSD and building specific details that will help you to prepare. As always, you can feel free to contact the Main Office at any time. Thank you for your continued support of the High School and the BBHCSD.

Arrival

- Parents can drop off students anywhere from front of the building along the sidewalk (main entrance, gyms, and auditorium)
- All students will have their temperature taken as they enter the building
- We continue to ask families to check temperatures and symptoms prior to arriving at school
- Please arrive on campus earlier due to increased traffic from lower bus ridership

Classroom

- Student desks will have plastic shields on them as an added layer of protection
- Social distancing to the extent possible in all settings
- Plexiglass shields have been added to lab environments

Hallways

- Hallways will have designated sides for traffic flow that students and staff must follow
- Passing time is 4 minutes between classes
- Consideration was given to one way hallways, but in numerous situations it would actually increase the transition time needed meaning students would be in unstructured environments longer traveling between rooms, also increasing the likelihood of being around more students in between classes

Lunch and Study Halls

- Students will check into a contact tracing form as they sit down for study hall or lunch
- The auxiliary gym will be open for study halls and lunches to reduce gathering sizes and to spread out students
- Open Campus will continue to be available to students in grades 10-12

Masks

- All students and staff are required to wear masks correctly (covering nose and mouth) at all times while in the building

Cleaning

- Additional custodial coverage for school hours was added at the start of the school year and will remain in place with the return to a five day a week model. This additional staff has been utilized to perform live time cleaning of high traffic spaces including restrooms, cafeteria areas, handrails, etc. When applicable this additional staffing will also be used to complete room fogging during the course of the school day when the room is not in use and staff is able to be relocated for the cleaning period.
- During the day, restrooms and high traffic areas are cleaned using an electrostatic cleaner known as an EDIC (Kaivac). This device dispenses a respiratory safe chemical (Vital Oxide) that both cleans and disinfects the area in which applied. The process takes roughly 30 minutes per area targeted.
- The entire high school is fogged three times a week with electrostatic cleaning processes. Regular and routine disinfection of all classroom areas occurs several times a week.
- Daily cleaning routines include wiping of all desk tops, door knobs, pencil sharpeners, switch plates, counters and sink basins with Super HDQL. All tiled areas are also treated with Super HDQL through wet-mopping practices.
- Each classroom has also been equipped with tubs of disinfecting wipes using Vital Oxide. These wipes are made available for both staff and student usage to provide additional comfort for those individuals wanting to ensure their work area has been tended to

Bus Transportation Reminders

- All students wear masks while being transported on the bus.
- Students also have assigned seats on the bus.
