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Return to 5-Day In-Person Learning Important Reminders

Students, staff and parents at Brecksville-Broadview Heights *Middle School* will return to 5-Day, In-Person Learning on Monday, October 26th. Together safely, the District is posting these *Important Reminders* so that everyone in our learning family can be better prepared for this return to learning every day. Please see the information below about critical aspects of daily life in the BBHCS and building specific details that will help you to prepare. As always, you can feel free to contact the Main Office at any time. Thank you for your continued support of the Middle School and the BBHCS.

Student and Staff Health and Safety

- Stay home when ill. Take temperature before coming to school. If your temperature is above 100.4, please stay home. We will utilize this [decision tree](#) based on specific symptoms and circumstances.
- Maintain physical distancing (at least 3 feet) while in classrooms and throughout the building wherever possible.
- Require students and staff to wear a mask at all times, covering nose to chin, with the exception of lunch.

Cleaning and Sanitizing of Building, Classrooms, and Common Areas

- Custodial staff will clean and disinfect commonly touched surfaces, such as workstations, countertops, railings, switch plates, door handles, and doorknobs routinely throughout the day.
- Disinfectant spray cleaner or disposable wipes (if available) are provided so that commonly touched surfaces can be cleaned by all before each use.
- A Clorox 360 electrostatic misting disinfectant machine will be used nightly.
- Open windows daily to support additional air flow. When weather does not permit windows to be opened while in use, open windows before school, after school, and when room is not in use.

Transportation

- All students who ride our buses will be required to wear a mask prior to entering the bus and for the duration of the trip.

Arrival

- Temperature checks will be taken indoors as students enter the building through either of the following doors: #5 (8th grade wing), #1 (main entrance), or #34 (front lot entrance).

Dismissal

- All students will be dismissed at approximately 3:05 pm from their 8th period class.
- All students are expected to report to their respective buses in a timely manner and to follow all physical distancing guidelines

Lockers

- Students will have an opportunity to visit their lockers once in the AM and once in the PM using a rotation schedule.

Hallways

- One-way hallways will be designated where possible.

Classrooms

- Students and teachers will maintain physical distancing between each other.
- Dividers will be utilized as an added layer of protection where appropriate.
- Reduce or eliminate the sharing or use of materials and equipment
- Masks/face coverings will be worn at all times.

Cafeteria/Study Halls

- Seating in the cafeteria and study halls will be limited to four students at a table to maintain physical distancing. A seating chart will be maintained. Students will have to sit in the same seat every day.
- Masks will need to be worn at all times except when eating or drinking.
- Sixth graders will eat in the cafeteria, gym lobby, and auditorium lobby.

Wellness/Mask Breaks

- Wellness breaks will be provided for all students opposite their lunch outside when possible.

Clinic

- Students that start to experience COVID-19 symptoms during the school day should report to the clinic for an immediate contact of parents/guardians for dismissal from school.
- Students experiencing symptoms will not be permitted to stay in the clinic to see if they feel better. Any student feeling ill will have their parents/guardians contacted for pick-up or dismissal for the day.
- Daily medications will be distributed in the “lobby” of the clinic (old teacher mailroom).
- Students taking medication should maintain social distancing while waiting for their medication and then promptly leave the clinic lobby following their visit.

School Visitation By Appointment Only

In an effort to limit the number of visitors at specific times and to better serve our students and their families, we ask parents/guardians to make appointments when needing to meet with faculty, administration, or school staff.

- All visitors must take their temperature, sign-in logging their name and contact information along with entering and exit times.
- All visitors must wear masks/ face coverings.
- All visitors must check in using LobbyGuard with a drivers license.
