



Proposed Learning Plan

Remainder of the 2020-2021 School Year
January 4th - June 2nd

PHASE 1

Remote learning for all students grades PK-12 January 4th - January 8th

Objective: Teachers and support staff instruct from home in a “district-wide quarantine” after the holidays.

PHASE 2

PK-4 continue remote learning <u>January 11th - January 14th</u> .	5-12 return to hybrid schedule <u>January 11th - January 29th</u> .
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Home learners PK-4 online learning option remains available.	Home learners 5-12 livestreaming and concurrent schedules.
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Objective: COVID cases locally and in the district will be closely monitored.

PHASE 3

K-4 five full days in-person <u>January 19th - June 2nd</u> . (PK four days)	5-12 attend five full days in-person <u>February 1st - June 2nd</u> .
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Home learners PK-4 online learning option remains available.	Home learners 5-12 livestreaming and concurrent schedules.
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Objective: BBHCS D continually striving to achieve its goal of making available five full days of in-person learning.



Continued Reminders & Considerations

Remainder of the 2020-2021 School Year

January 4th - June 2nd

- If you intend on switching learning models (i.e., from online to in-person or vice versa), please contact your building principal by January 8, 2021
- Masks will continue to be worn by students (K-12) and staff at all times
- All cleaning protocols and procedures will remain in place
- BBHCSD will continue to monitor guidance from the Cuyahoga County Board of Health, vigilantly assess students and staff for COVID-19 symptoms, investigate outbreaks, and conduct contact tracing
- BBHCSD will continue to stress the importance of hand washing and promote the use of hand sanitizer
- State mandated standardized testing will proceed as scheduled
- The BBHCSD meal program will continue
- All sporting events TBD
- All extracurriculars will be postponed
- Beekeepers TBD (but will not be available in Phase One)
- Daily, parents and guardians must check temperatures, as well as check for COVID-19 symptoms, before students leave the house
- To the extent possible, physical distancing will be maintained among students and staff in school environments, including classrooms, hallways, restrooms, cafeteria, playground, drop-off and pick-up locations, and school buses
- No field trips or large group events where intermingling occurs (no renting of facilities)
- No school visitors (except by appointment or in extenuating circumstances; i.e., emergencies)
