- The BBHCSD will continue communicating with families throughout the summer, particularly as news emerges regarding statewide directives for the 2020-2021 School Year. Information will be posted on a newly designed website that will launch over the summer with greater access to social media platforms and information. The District is dedicated to keeping everyone informed in as timely a manner as possible with important news.
- BeeKeepers will be closed for the Summer of 2020. Given the restrictions from the State of Ohio and the circumstances around us all, our team felt extremely limited in providing the same level of camp experience and meaningful engagement as in years past. Please know that the decision to cancel BeeKeepers was not taken lightly. Ultimately, we chose to err on the side of caution, safety, health and wellness for everyone involved. We apologize for this inconvenience, but trust that you will understand. Please note that refunds can be issued to families that do not plan to enroll in the future. - Refunds and/or credits for All-Day Kindergarten and PreSchool are 100% complete. Pay-to-Participate calculations are still underway and cannot be finalized until year-end fees are correct. Other refunds/credits will begin processing next week and then finally expect to have all refunds/credits handled by June 20th. Thank you for your patience during this process. If you have any questions, please speak to your building office or specific department prior to contacting the Treasurer's Office.
- Those families in need of meals during the summer months should consult the [Ohio Department of Education Meal Program Map](#) to identify sites offering meals through the Seamless Summer Option or the Summer Food Service Program. Sites operate as open, restricted open or targeted outreach sites. While the BBHCSD will suspend its Grab-and-Go program while not in school for the summer, this may be a helpful resource to families.

Finally, while today marks the last official day of the school year, please consider participating in our Class of 2020 Commencement Day Parade on Saturday, June 13th that will depart the Broadview Heights Community Center at 11:30 a.m., travel east on Oakes Road, north on Route 21 to Mill Road and conclude at the Middle School parking lot. Bring your family to sit along the parade route, mindfully social-distanced, and wave to support our graduating senior class. The parade will be led by the Cleveland Metroparks Mounted Police Unit and will be an exciting opportunity to commemorate our wonderful graduating senior class.
