## **Transportation and Traffic Flow Updates**

As has been shared, traffic flow patterns at the HS and MS campus have been enhanced, and we ask that you keep on the lookout for new signage directing motorists on campus, and on Mill Road. Please also consult the maps posted on our Transportation Page and Quick Links section on the building pages as well. A few highlighted changes at the HS and MS campus to note:

### **High School and Middle School Traffic Reminders**

- HS student parking lots have been assigned numbers, where lot #1 is the senior lot, #2 will be the Honors student parking lot, #3 will be the lot between the HS and MS behind the 8th grade wing, and #4 will be our future student parking lot on the hillside between the HS and MS. Signage throughout the campus will be marked with these corresponding numbers.
- Parents who have *students attending both the HS and MS* will be asked to drop off MS students on the hill approaching the HS first, and then continue to the HS student drop off area.

### **Elementary School Traffic and Food Services Reminders**

- Please consult the traffic flow map on the Transportation Page and our Quick Links section on the building home page.
- At the Elementary School, parents will be required to login to the Pikmykids app to notify building staff to release your child.

To all families and motorists, we thank you in advance for your patience and flexibility. Please
