Important Reminders for the First Day of School and Beyond

Dear Brecksville-Broadview Heights City Schools Community,

Classes start for the 2021-2022 School Year tomorrow, August 18th! After a successful convocation with the staff earlier in the week, we are all looking forward to seeing our students' smiling faces back in the District. Please keep in mind that mask-wearing is *strongly recommended* for the upcoming school year, however, District leaders will closely monitor data on a regular basis. While we will strongly recommend masks, if the evidence demonstrates an increase in numbers or a spread at anytime, the BBHCSD will implement a universal mask mandate for a period of time, if necessary.

Additionally, the District will continue monitoring COVID-19 cases and will follow the quarantine guidance from the Ohio Department of Health.
