Reminders for Home Football Games

The Brecksville-Broadview Heights City Schools have already kicked-off the fall extra-curricular season at the High School and Middle School levels, and while we are excited for the community to support our Bees on the interscholastic fields and courts of competition, the district is asking you to keep the following important regulations in mind, for everyone's safety and enjoyment of these events. Please be reminded that:

Student sections for home varsity games will be as follows:

- Grades 9 – 12: designated Swarm section at south end of home bleachers.
- Grades 6 – 8: top portion of student section, behind HS Swarm section, at south end of home bleachers.

Students will be able to go to the concession stand and use the restroom, but please return directly to the designated student section for everyone's safety.

- All Elementary students (K-5) must be accompanied by an adult.
- Footballs, soccer balls, and other equipment are not permitted in the stadium.

The BBHCS D greatly values student attendance at our sporting events as a way to promote school spirit! We ask that you abide by these standards, and extend our gratitude to you for helping to make this experience enjoyable for everyone!
