Important Revised Learning Plan for Remainder of 2020-2021 School Year

Dear Brecksville-Broadview Heights City Schools Community,

The Board of Education met on Wednesday, December 16th to comprehensively discuss and finalize the District's overall learning plan upon return from Winter Break and through the remainder of the 2020-2021 School Year. While the [full plan is posted on the BBHCS D website](#), a summary of its highlights are below:

- **December 21st- January 1st:** Winter Break. No school for students or staff
- **January 4th - January 8th:** Remote learning for all students in grades PK-12
- **January 11th - January 14th:** Grades PK-4 continued remote learning
- **January 11th - January 29th:** Grades 5-12 return to hybrid schedule
- **January 19th - June 2nd:** Grades K-4 five full days in-person (PreK four days in-person)
- **February 1st - June 2nd:** Grades 5-12 attend five full days in-person

More information will be forthcoming from your buildings in the next day or so, and we ask you to please remain posted for more details. These finalized plans come as a result of continued monitoring of data from multiples sources, thoroughly analyzing trends and recognizing the needs of our students and staff for maximizing our educational experience despite the circumstances related to the coronavirus around us. Thank you to those who have shared their input to members of the District's leadership team.
