CVCC Early Placement Program Update

The 2019-2020 Early Placement program for CVCC's eligible (B average and nine or fewer absences during junior and senior years at CVCC) best High School seniors started on January 21, 2020. During Early Placement, students work four afternoons a week instead of attending their CVCC program so that they can have real-life work experience to increase their job ready skills and possibly lead to full time employment following the completion of their program. The second release of students (B average and eleven or fewer absences) was February 18. As of February 25, CVCC has 39 students from 13 different programs participating in Early Placement or Paid Internship. Students are making a minimum of \$8.70 (2020 Ohio Minimum Wage) up to \$16.00 per hour at this time. The Sports Medicine Exercise Science Program also started their Unpaid Internships on February 19, twenty students are participating and they will be on the job two days a week until April. We wish these students the best of luck as they contribute to our region's workforce.

Educators Rising Community Service Project

From Monday, February 3- Friday, February 14, CVCC's Education Professions program, instructed by Mrs. Josephine Everhart, participated in the Educators Rising state-wide community service project by collecting personal items for babies and children in the



foster care system for both Summit and Cuyahoga County. Though the community service project formally ended on Friday, February 7, CVCC's Education Professions program extended the collection date to the following week in hopes of receiving as many donations as possible to give to those in need.
