Dear Mr. Bradesca:

This letter is being sent to notify you of my intent to recommend, commencing with the 2015-2016 school year, a resolution to the Brecksville-Broadview Heights Board of Education declaring transportation of students living in the Brecksville-Broadview Heights City School District, attending St. Ignatius High School, impractical pursuant to the requirements of Ohio Revised Code §3327 and the procedures set forth by the Ohio Department of Education. It should be noted that the district will continue to provide transportation for the remainder of the current school year.

The following factors, as identified in Ohio Revised Code §3327, have been considered:

1. The time and distance required to provide the transportation.
2. The number of pupils to be transported.
3. The cost of providing transportation in terms of equipment, maintenance, personnel, and administration.
4. Whether similar or equivalent service is provided to other pupils eligible for transportation.
5. Whether and to what extent the additional service unavoidably disrupts current transportation schedules.
6. Whether other reimbursable types of transportation are available.

A summary of our analysis is outlined below:

Transportation cost for St. Ignatius High School

WAGES: \$25.00 per hour X 4 hours per day X 188 days (includes 8 holidays) =	\$18,800
MILEAGE: 68 miles per day @ \$1.22 per mile X 180 days =	<u>\$14,933</u>
YEARLY TOTAL	\$33,733

RIDERSHIP: AM = average 4-8 students; PM = average 1-3 students

I anticipate the Brecksville-Broadview Heights Board of Education will pass the aforementioned resolution during its January 26, 2015 meeting with a declaration that it is impractical to transport the students identified and offering the parents/guardians of said students Payment-In-Lieu of Transportation.
