

**Brecksville-Broadview Heights City school District
Resolution Adopting a Calamity Day Alternative Make-up Plan
for Hilton Elementary for the 2013 - 2014 School Year**

Whereas, the Brecksville-Broadview Heights Board of Education desires that students have learning opportunities even when schools are closed for any of the reasons specified in section 3317.01 of the Ohio Revised Code and in excess of the number of days authorized in section 3313.48; and

Whereas, section 3313.88 authorizes a board of education to file a plan with the Ohio Department of Education to provide online learning opportunities/blizzard bags for students in lieu of attendance on such excess days;

NOW THEREFORE BE IT, AND IT IS, HEREBY RESOLVED that the Brecksville-Broadview Heights Board of Education hereby approves the following plan and authorizes its filing with the Ohio Department of Education.

**Calamity Day Alternative Make-up Plan for Hilton Elementary
for the 2013 - 2014 School Year**

Pursuant to the Ohio Revised Code section 3313.88, the Board of Education of the Brecksville-Broadview Heights City School District hereby authorizes the following plan to allow students of Hilton Elementary to access and complete classroom lessons in order to complete one (1) day of instruction in excess of the number of days permitted under section 3313.48 because of the closing of school for any of the reasons specified in section 3317.01 (Other temporary circumstances due to utility failure - power outage).

1. This plan is submitted, pursuant to the approval of the board of education, on March 17, 2014.
2. This plan includes the written consent of the teachers' employee representative as designated under division (B) of section 4117.04. Such consent is on file in the official file of the board of education and is hereby incorporated into this plan as if specifically rewritten.
3. Not later than March 20 of the 2013 - 2014 school year, each classroom teacher in Hilton Elementary (Pre-K - 3) shall develop a sufficient number of lessons for each grade level.
4. Staff members designated by the appropriate administrator shall make the designated lessons available for the district's web site and prepared for the students in "blizzard bags". Each lesson shall be created, posted on the Hilton Elementary web site, and distributed in "blizzard bags" for each grade level for the day of the school closing. "Blizzard bags" shall be distributed to all students no later than March 20, 2014.
5. Each student enrolled in a grade level for which a lesson is posted shall be granted a two week period March 21 - April 4, 2014, to complete the lesson. If the student does not complete the lesson within this time period, the student will receive an incomplete or failing grade on the lesson(s) unless a sufficient reason is provided to the teacher.
